On behalf of the Officers, Committee and Members of the Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club of U.K. I would like to offer our strong objections to the fact that Mr Alexander Däuber has been given permission to crossbreed the Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever with an Unknown Waterdog Breed.

Mr Däuber had already been in touch with us to gain our support, which we had refused as there is no firm evidence whatsoever to back up his reasoning for wanting to crossbreed and we feel it could possibly introduce far more problems into the breed and would change the Toller as we know it FOREVER, this is certainly not the way forward.

We are in touch with other Toller Clubs worldwide also Toller Members of the DRC and they all feel the same way as we do! we ALL agree that surely the Country of Origin i.e. Canada should be the only one to be able to take such drastic steps to change such a lovely well known breed.

I do sincerely hope you will take our strong concerns into view and withdraw permission for Mr Däuber to carry out crossbreeding of the Toller as it will isolate all German Toller Breeders / Owners from the rest of the world purely because of the views of one person.
